Project title: Strengthening transparency and accountability for gender equality in Western Balkans and Moldova (Gender Budget Watchdog Network, Phase II)

1. PUBLIC CALL FOR IT specialist to upload 7 online courses for GBWN E-platform on five languages - ENG, ALB, MK, ROM, SRB/MNE/BiH and provide technical assistance in provision of trainings

<p>Background</p>	<p>In the first phase of the project a GBWN academy was created on the GBWN e learning platform. For the time being only one training is offered in English. The academy is planned to feature GRB training for CSOs in all 5 local languages. It offers training on gender budget watch using the 3 basic tools: gender budget analysis, gender beneficiary assessment and gender impact analysis. In this, II phase of the project, learning materials on watch dogging of climate change financing will be offered in online format in English and all 5 project languages, as well as the training on how CSOs can increase participation and influence in international fora and hold governments accountable. In total it makes 7 courses that should be available in English and 5 local languages.</p>

Specifically, the action is focusing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - women's rights organizations to increase their capacity, knowledge and skills regarding climate change policies, the climate finance landscape and improve their understanding of processes, entry points, gaps and potentials for engendering; and - environmental organizations that need to increase their knowledge and skills on gender mainstreaming of climate change policies and climate financing.
